### Scope

Cultural resources inventory

### Project Description

PG&E plans to obtain a right-of-way to continue operation of electrical transmission and distribution facilities on, or partially on, land under the jurisdiction of the Los Padres National Forest. At the request of the Los Padres National Forest, cultural resource inventories were conducted for seven existing electrical transmission line rights-of-way (along with associated access roads), five feeder electrical distribution rights-of-way and nine electrical distribution lines. The seven electrical transmission lines are proposed for aggregation into a single Master Transmission Easement, the five feeder electrical distribution lines into a single Master Distribution Easement, and the nine electrical distribution lines into a single Master Special Use Permit. The authorization would allow the continued operation and maintenance of existing PG&E electric facilities on the Los Padres National Forest.

Approximately 356 acres at 23 separate locations were surveyed, most under conditions of difficult terrain and access. This cultural resources survey was conducted in compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
