Scope

Third Party NEPA Compliance Inspectors for the Bureau of Land Management

Project Description

Transcon Environmental served at the Third Party Environmental Compliance Inspector for the Bureau of Land Management for the construction of a wind farm in Milford, Utah and an approximately 90 mile transmission line from Milford, Utah to Delta, Utah. The project consists of 165 wind turbines, a substation, operations and maintenance yard, and an approximately 90 mile transmission line. Transcon served as the BLM authorized agent. The wind farm is a two phase project. Phase I was completed November 10, 2009 with the successful erection of 98 wind turbines and the transmission line, the operations and maintenance yard and the substation. Phase II involves the erection of 68 more turbines and is currently underway.

Transcon Environmental acts on behalf of the Bureau of Land Management in the field ensuring the proponent follows the Plan of Development and ensures sensitive biological and cultural resources are not impacted by construction.
