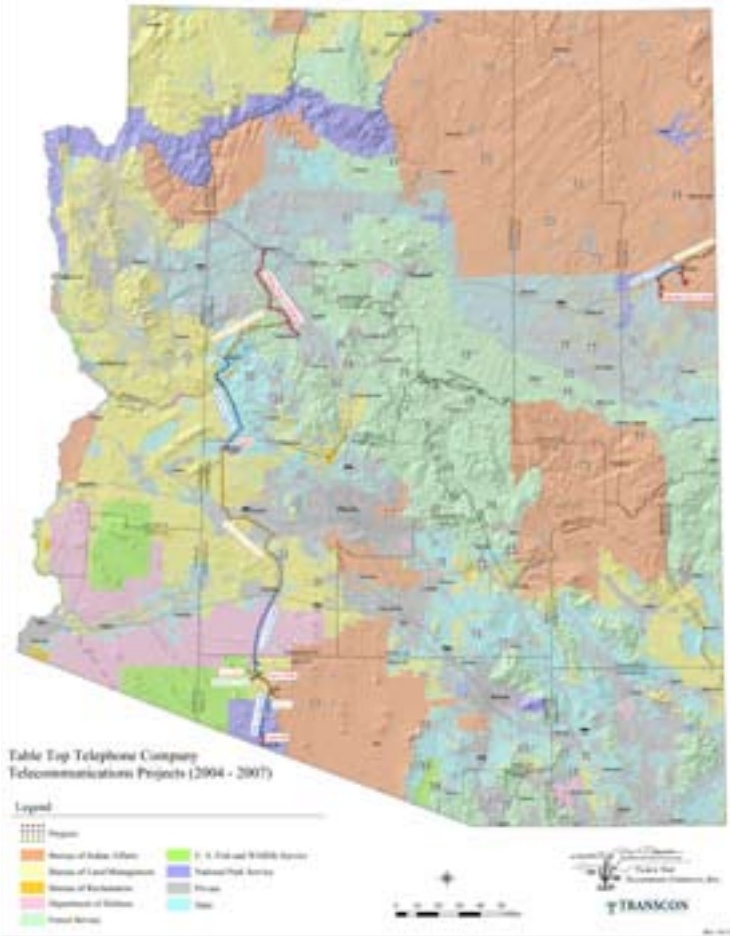

Project Description

Transcon oversaw the progress completion of all environmental requirements including various products such as: Environmental Assessments or Environmental Reports for the Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, and Department of Defense; Cultural Resources Reports, Treatment Plans, and monitoring/treatment activities for the Arizona State Historic Preservation Office; Biological Assessments and/or Biological Evaluations for the US Fish and Wildlife Service; and Environmental Certification for the Arizona Department of Transportation. Additionally, Transcon completed all the Clean Water Act compliance requirements including the documentation of jurisdictional washes pursuant to Section 404, the development of submittal package for clearance related to Section 401 Water Quality Certification, and the development of Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans. Other activities included training construction crews on sensitive resource avoidance, and monitoring and inspection.
